- 2) Technical literature (brochure, catalogue, product data sheet)
- 3) In case of mixture, composite goods consisting of different materials or made up of different components, a detailed percentage breakdown of the product composition.
- 4) The process of manufacture.
- 5) Digital picture or photograph, drawing, video, CD Rom.
- 6) Sample, if practicable.
- 7) Any other relevant information.
